In January 2023 the Vision Implementation Team began meeting and preparing for a larger meeting of leaders from across the nine clusters of DBF. On the 29th of April 2023 we had a meeting with 70 leaders from the DBF churches. This meeting has ensured that all the Clusters and churches are aware of the vision of DBF. We are working toward consolidating the plans of all the clusters so that we have a clear overview of the plans for DBF over the next 10 years.

### Clusters & Churches

DBF follows an organizational model where the fellowship is divided into 9 clusters. Each cluster has two or more churches attached in it. Every cluster is a led by a Lead Pastor along with a Cluster Leadership team made up of Elders and Deacons from the churches that make up that Cluster. Under these 9 clusters, there are 36 worship services that take place every weekend, shepherded by 20 Pastors and 8 Ministry Coordinators.

in In April 2022 the Nihal Vihar DBF church was started under the DBF providing Pastoral leadership to this church.

In November 2022 DRF Greater Noida Church was planted under the DBF Central Cluster, Pastor Manay Das and a few members from DBF Central were involved in planting this church.

In February 2023 DBF Gurgaon Life Hinglish Church was relaunched. The church began online in 2021 before meeting in-person in November 2021. After facing a few challenges, they were able to relaunch in February this year at their own rented space. Pastor Gladwin is the pastor of this church.
